

Everything You Need to Know About Carpet Runners

No, a carpet runner is not someone who puts on their jogging shoes just to run along the hallway carpet. A carpet runner is really a piece of carpet that is used in a hallway of a home with the basic purpose of keeping wear off the actual floor. There are many different types of carpet runners to choose from, including white carpet runners, solid carpet runners, leather carpet runners, stair tread carpet runners, roll carpet runners, plastic carpet runners, stairway carpet runners, and even area carpet runners that span over a greater area of space.

You should first determine just where in your home you are planning on putting the carpet runner before buying it so that you can select the specific one that is going to be best suited. Antique carpet runners, for instance, would be best in a bedroom or sitting room where they are more for decoration than actual use, whereas wool carpet runners or vinyl carpet runners are able to handle a lot more tear, so they could be used at the entryway of your home or in the main hallway.

The Installation Process

If you are not comfortable with installing your carpet runners on your own, there are professionals available that you can call and have come do the work for you although the installation process is typically so quick and simple that you can easily handle doing it on your own.

However, the fact that the installation process itself is going to vary depending on particular type of carpet runner you decided to go with, you may want to ask a professional for advice. You see, carpet runners for wheelchairs and carpet runners for the hallway need to be thicker and stapled over twice in order to ensure they are stable, but office carpet runners and church carpet runners do not need to be worried about so much in this regards. How your carpet runners are fastened is especially important because you can either use staples and a staple gun or tacks and a tack hammer to install your carpet runner. Asking a professional for advice in these areas may prove very valuable.

Care and Maintenance

When it comes to the care and maintenance of your carpet runners, the best idea is to buy washable carpet runners so that you can just pick them up and throw them in the washing machine whenever you need to. Persian carpet runners, clear carpet runners, Berber carpet runners, Tartan carpet runners, and custom carpet runners, however, should all be dry cleaned only. In the case of those carpet runners that can't be washed, you may want to consider clear plastic carpet runners to place on top of your carpet runners to keep them clean and looking like new.
